

## **Bilio Tsoukala (Journalist)**

She graduated from the Department of Economics at the University of Piraeus and continued her postgraduate studies in Paris. She studied journalism at the French Institute of Journalism (I.F.P.) and political science at the University of Sorbonne Paris 2, where she obtained a postgraduate diploma in Political Science (D.E.A.). At the same time, she attended courses in English literature, film studies, and political economy.

Since 1984, she has worked for magazines and newspapers ("ENA," "Anti," "Woman," "Click," "Ego," "Mesimvrini," "Kerdos"). From 1994 to 2006, she was a member of the editorial team and wrote for the magazine "Madame Figaro."

She was one of the pioneers of Free Radio. In 1986, she was a member of the Initiative Group for Free Radio "Channel 15."

She hosted radio shows on the first municipal radio station "Athens 9.84" and later on TOP FM, ANT-1, and "Alpha Radio."

She has worked in television since 1995, presenting cultural programs such as "Sin and Plin," one of the first cultural magazines on public television.

From 2003 to 2013, she curated and presented the daily live cultural show "Ehei Goutso" on ERT.
